The house is distributed over several levels. The main floor features a fully fitted kitchen, guest toilet and a spacious, light-filled living and dining area with direct access to a pleasant terrace with open sea views, perfect for sunny breakfasts or sunset dinners.

On the upper level there is a large attic-style bedroom with private toilet and exceptional views. On the lower level you will find the spacious master bedroom with en-suite bathroom, two additional bedrooms and another full bathroom, with direct access to the private outdoor area consisting of a

cosy 27 m² porch and a 33 m² garden, an ideal space to enjoy the Costa del Sol climate all year round.

The property also benefits from a large multifunctional basement including a lounge area, games space, laundry room and storage, providing valuable additional living space for family life.

Features include air conditioning, a solar hot water system and private parking directly at the entrance of the property.

As an important added value, the owner includes the share in Club Babylon, allowing access to its swimming pool and communal facilities for a monthly fee.
